

**Episode 6: Handout #6 – Coroner Report (Appendix B)**

Notation of self-inflicted cuts found on subject’s left forearm, proximal to the radial and distal to the antecubital fossa. The wounds are uniform and distinctly orderly, contraindication to self-harm or self-injury (see DSM III, pp. 483). Four sets of wound patterns were identified, as outlined below.

Cuts appear to be made with a burning/cutting tool, such as a lower power laser or very fine high heat writing tool, also contraindicated to normal self-harm/self-injury behaviors (DSM III, pp. 485).
