High-Profile Assassinations by the Tolokoshe

Executive Summary

AEGIS has identified a series of high-profile assassinations in Central and South America, attributed to the Tolokoshe, an African Quasar team known for their precision and lethality. Intelligence gathered through decrypted DESPIRUS communication channels indicates the group is operating with high-level coordination and substantial financial backing. The next probable target is President Dina Boluarte of Peru.

Situation Overview

- **Assassination Pattern:** Over the past six months, several political and military figures in Central and South America have been assassinated under suspicious circumstances. The methods used suggest the involvement of highly skilled Quasars.
- **Perpetrators:** The Tolokoshe, a notorious African Quasar team, have been identified as the executors of these hits. Their involvement was confirmed through intercepted and decrypted DESPIRUS communications.
- **Communications:** DESPIRUS channels have revealed encrypted messages and financial transactions linked to the Tolokoshe. The communications indicate a clear pattern and strategic intent behind the assassinations.

Threat Assessment

- **Target:** President Dina Boluarte of Peru.
- **Rationale:** President Boluarte has recently intensified anti-Quasar measures and has been a vocal critic of Venezuela and has been in talks with the United States regarding the Mendelman Treaty, which would formalize direction of aid and resources to Peru to fight localized Quasar threats. This has likely placed her in the crosshairs of Matar Sanguo, aka Killblood, who it seems has hired the Tolokoshe for these and other assassinations.
- **Reference:** Previous regionally-based assassinations likely by Tolokoshe, see Appendix 1A.
- **Probability:** High. Based on the pattern of previous targets and recent intelligence, there is a significant risk of an assassination attempt on President Boluarte.

AEGIS Response Plan

- **Deployment:** Team ASTRA will be deployed to Peru with immediate effect.
 - **Composition:** Team ASTRA comprises elite operatives with specialized skills in Quasar threat neutralization, cyber warfare, and close protection.
 - **Objectives:**
 - Ensure the safety of President Boluarte.
 - Identify and neutralize any Tolokoshe operatives within the region.

- Secure and analyze further communications to prevent future threats.

Operational Details

- **Pre-Deployment:**
 - Comprehensive briefing and coordination with Peruvian security forces.
 - Establishment of secure communication lines between AEGIS, UNCOS, and local authorities.
- **On-Ground Activities:**
 - Immediate implementation of enhanced protective measures around President Boluarte.
 - Deployment of cyber units to monitor and intercept any further DESPIRUS communications.
 - Strategic placement of ASTRA operatives in key locations to detect and neutralize threats.
- **Post-Deployment:**
 - Continuous monitoring of the threat landscape.
 - Coordination with international intelligence agencies to dismantle the Tolokoshe support elements, which seem to be Sanguo Brotherhood operatives.
 - Reporting and debriefing to UNCOS and relevant stakeholders.

Conclusion

The threat posed by the Tolokoshe is significant and imminent. AEGIS, in coordination with UNCOS and local Peruvian authorities, is committed to safeguarding President Dina Boluarte and thwarting the Tolokoshe. Immediate deployment of Team ASTRA is essential to achieving these objectives and ensuring regional stability.

Action Required

- **Approval:** Requesting immediate approval for the deployment of Team ASTRA to Peru.
- **Support:** Coordination with UNCOS for additional resources and intelligence support.
- **Reporting:** Regular updates to be provided to UNCOS on the operation's progress and any significant developments.

Appendix 1A

Assassination Targets by the Tolokoshe

1. Juan Carlos Mendoza

- **Position:** Minister of Defense
- **Country:** Colombia
- **Date:** June 8, 2023
- **Method:** Energy blast from sniper during a military parade
- **Details:** The shot was taken from an impressive distance, demonstrating exceptional skill and precision and exceptional energy control.
- **Motive:** Coordination with AEGIS operations during a recent arms smuggling deterrent operation.

2. Isabela Torres

- **Position:** CEO of Energía Verde
- **Country:** Brazil
- **Date:** June 25, 2023
- **Method:** Died in a fire at her home along with family
- **Details:** Highly intensive heat source rated at over 3000 C. Signature of death indicates that family was systematically burned one after another.
- **Motive:** Was slated to provide significant resource and aid toward the Soldas Estrella augmentation program, designed to provide Quasar-level threat assessment and response in Brazil.

3. Maria Elena Rojas

- **Position:** Chief Justice of the Supreme Court
- **Country:** Chile
- **Date:** June 29, 2023
- **Method:** Found dead in her home, which suffered structural collapse
- **Details:** There were no signs of forced entry and torture.
- **Motive:** Was due to rule on the treaty negotiations to allow extradition of Sanguo Brotherhood operatives to the United States.

4. Eduardo Castillo

- **Position:** Mayor of Panama City
- **Country:** Panama
- **Date:** May 3, 2024
- **Method:** Dozens of small stab wounds
- **Details:** The attack was carried out with unidentified weapons, the injuries indicating unusual angles of entry and exit from the body. Signs of torture indicated before death.
- **Motive:** After the Martessos Massacre in April, he has been coordinating with AEGIS to develop strategies and obtain resources needed to fight a pervasive Sanguo Brotherhood presence in Panama City.
